You may be dyslexic if:

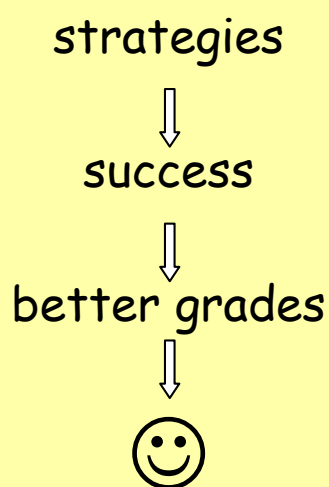
- you are much better at speaking than writing and / or

Why does it help to know ?

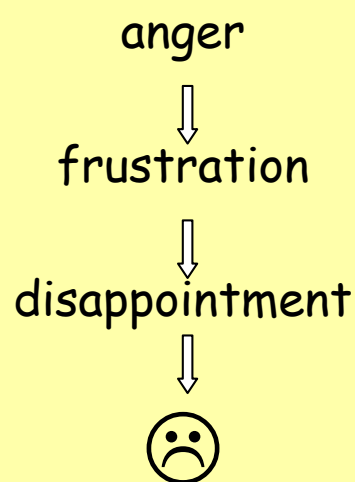
If you are dyslexic, you may:
